

We hope you are excited about your trip to Los Angeles to participate in the IPC conference at UCLA! Most of the conference activities will take place in the Ackerman Student Union. In preparation, here is some important information to guide you.

Getting to Meeting Locations

From the Hotel Palomar: There will be a UCLA shuttle running between the Hotel Palomar and the Ackerman Turnaround. Shuttle service begins at 7:20am on Friday morning. A shuttle schedule will be provided for you when you check in to the hotel. You can also walk to the Ackerman Union in about 20 minutes. Please see the attached map for hotel and Ackerman locations. There is also a map of UCLA at the hotel.

From the Hilgard House: You can walk from the Hilgard House to both IPAM and the Ackerman Union in under 10 minutes. Please see the attached map for hotel and Ackerman locations. There is also a map of UCLA at the hotel.

Driving to UCLA: If you are driving to UCLA, parking has been reserved for this event in Lot 2 on the corner of Hilgard and Westholme. The cost for parking is \$10. You will need to first visit the parking kiosk directly across from Lot 2 to pay for parking and get a parking ticket. Then go across the small street and parking in Lot 2. Please tell them that you are there for an IPAM event. Please see the attached map for Lot 2, IPAM and Ackerman locations.
